

Band Camp Contract

I _____, the undersigned, do agree to abide by the following rules and regulations while at band camp.

All rules set forth in/by the Trenton High School Code of Conduct, Skyline Camp, and the Band Camp Committee must be followed and will be strictly enforced. The band director and the chaperones reserve the right to establish additional rules as needed. Failure to abide by these rules will result in corrective action which may include student dismissal from camp. Upon student dismissal from camp, a parent, guardian, or parent designated responsible adult will be required to promptly pick the student up from camp.

Personal Belongings

- The following items are not permitted at camp: Cigarettes or other tobacco products, electronic cigarettes or other vaping products and paraphernalia, alcohol, illicit drugs, both prescription and over-the-counter drugs, energy drinks, weapons (including blades), candles, lighters, and other combustibles.
- Chaperones reserve the right to search personal belongings of all participants both at check-in and while at camp. At least two chaperones will be present for all searches. Any personal item that is deemed to be inappropriate for any reason will be confiscated until the conclusion of camp.
- The standards for acceptable camp items are subject to change at any time and are at the discretion of the camp chaperones.
- Trenton Band, band boosters, camp chaperones, and/or Skyline Camp are not responsible for any lost or damaged belongings while at camp.

Appropriate Attire

- All students are expected to dress appropriately while at camp. Shirts and shoes are required at the dining hall and in all community buildings
- Chaperones reserve the right to request changes of attire for any student deemed to be inappropriately dressed.
- The standards for acceptable camp attire are subject to change at any time and are at the discretion of the camp chaperones.

Activities

- All students must attend, and remain at, all scheduled activities including practice sessions, marching, and evening social events. Attendance is mandatory but participation is optional.
- The Senior All Night Dance on Thursday is for 12th graders only and all other students are expected to adhere to the designated curfew times.
- Students must remain on camp property at all times. A parent must notify a chaperone if the student is leaving the grounds for any reason.

Lodging

- Students are assigned to specific rooms or cabins and are expected to remain in their assigned room or cabin for the duration of camp. Questions or Issues involving room or cabin mates must be discussed with camp chaperones and will be resolved as reasonably as possible.
- Male and female campers are allowed in each other's rooms or cabins during designated times only. Designated times are generally during break times, after lunch, and before 10:00 pm. Designated times are subject to change at any time and are at the discretion of the chaperones.

- When males and females are in rooms or cabins together the doors must remain open and there must be at least three people in the room or cabin, two of which are female.
- All students are expected to be in their assigned lodgings at by 10:30 pm. Lights out and quiet time will be at 11:00 pm. All students are expected to remain in their assigned rooms or cabins for the night. Curfew times may be adjusted by the camp chaperones as deemed appropriate or necessary.
- All students are expected to be respectful of the camp facilities and to report any damaged camp property to the chaperones as soon as it is discovered. The parents and/or guardians of any student found to be involved with causing damage to camp property will be held responsible for payment for those damages.

Health and Safety

- There will be a health officer present for the duration of camp. All injuries, however minor, should be reported to a chaperone. First aid will be administered by the health officer as deemed necessary.
- The health officer will be charged with maintaining and dispensing all prescription and over-the-counter medications for students during camp. Students are allowed to keep rescue inhalers in their own possession.
- All students are required to have a water bottle or Gatorade type beverage on the practice field at all times.
- A student’s illness may result in being dismissed from camp. If a student becomes incapacitated and is unable to participate appropriately in band camp practices and activities, parents will be notified and dismissal will follow accordingly.
- Trash must be disposed of in designated receptacles.
- All food must remain in sealed containers at all times. Sealed containers shall be considered plastic containers with sealable lids. The following items are NOT examples of sealed containers: Dresser drawers, duffle bags, suit cases, pillow cases, or any other item that cannot be sealed with a lid at all times.
- No food shall be removed from the dining hall, community buildings, camp activities, or personal belongings for any other purpose other than personal consumption.
- Pets and animals are not to be brought to camp. Please report any stray animals to a chaperone or camp staff.
- Campfires of moderate size may only be built in designated campfire locations by chaperones or camp staff.

Visitors and Vehicles

- Visitation during camp is not permitted without permission. If a visit is required it must be approved by a chaperone.
- Visitor cars are subject to inspection by chaperones. Visitors may not bring drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products to camp.
- Vehicles are permitted only on established roads and must observe the 15 mph speed limit while on Skyline property. Vehicles should be left parked and locked in areas designated by chaperones and/or camp staff.
