Meeting called to order at 637pm, (9) attendees.

Mr. K Report: Pep Band will be formed for the hockey semifinal and final this weekend. Bus and tickets have been arranged. 2nd Trimester Concert was a success with the date change from the weather. Musical "Mamma Mia" is coming together nicely for the show March 26-28. Jazz Band is coming together for Spring events. Working on getting a prop for next years show, there have been issues with the transaction, we may have to look at other options. Trying to setup an alternate performance for October, looking at an event in Belleville or maybe a parade.

Band Camp - Lara Laney: 107 paid deposit thus far, still taking payments. All attendees must complete all paperwork and mail to PO Box. Still taking payments. Could use some additional male chaperones but medical staff looks to be all set.

Musical - Kristie Irvin will take care of the flowers for sale at the musical, March 26-28.

Spring Raffle - Planning committee has settled on prizes and donations. Event is April 27 and reminder to parents that this is a whole band fundraiser not just form jazz. Raffle tickets will be mailed to each band family at the end of March.

Banquet - Denise Marshall has designed the flyer and it is available in the band room. Flyer will also be posted on the boosters website and emailed out. Banquet is May 5 at Crystal Gardens.

Invitational - September 26 at Farrer Field. Construction on the field is underway. Field will be complete by that time but unsure of surrounding construction. May impact parking and staging areas but we will not know how much until the date is closer.

Golf Outing - Jeff Loger has volunteered to look into a golf outing as a potential band fundraiser in the late summer. He is going to check on some things and report back to the board.

501c3 Status - all set from the IRS, tax return needs filing by May 15. Mike Irvin and Mark Revesz will handle.

Treasury Report: finances good, band camp money is coming in and deposits made to camp. Mike needs someone to take over Treasurer role in July so he can transition to new treasurer. No candidates have come forward. Mike will present at AMS Booster Meeting on 3/10.

Haventown Cleaners is ready for uniforms. Julie and Kristie will handle the delivery and pickup. \$7.50 per uniform. Discussion on age and condition of the uniforms, we hope to get a few more years out of the current set.

Nominations were held for the band boosters executive board: No nominees for Treasurer, Duane Lawrence for Secretary, Jami Melton for Vice President and Mark Revesz for President. Nominations will remain open until the April Meeting, at which time voting will take place.
